AGGREGATE SIZES & Aesthetics in Terrazzo

A terrazzo floor is comprised of marble or glass aggregate, typically representing 70% of the flooring system and the additional 30% is the epoxy binder. Aggregates range on a scale system and are most often used as #0's, #1's and #2's. Aggregate crushers have adopted standards within the industry and grade the chips according to size in conformity. Based on the type of look you are trying to achieve and other various factors, the combination of various chip sizes within the formula can significantly change the ultimate appearance of the floor. The images below demonstrate these variances.
